

1 Q. Okay. And for what period of time if you
2 recall did these changes that you just described continue?

3 A. Until the end of the relationship. I mean, I
4 saw him less at the very end. But the last significant time
5 where I saw him under those circumstances was at spring
6 training of 2003 where we were in a setting like that
7 together, and then two other occasions after that before the
8 relationship ended.

9 Q. And was his -- from the time that you
10 noticed -- first started to notice these changes, was Mr.
11 Bonds' temperament at all different?

12 A. Yes. Those were the changes that were not the
13 physical ones, but he was always -- like I said, always
14 contentious, always what I would describe as a rather, you
15 know, difficult man, hard to love because he's just
16 difficult like that.

17 But toward the end is when he -- at the very
18 end of our relationship when he became violent with me. But
19 prior to that, he had always only made threats.

20 Q. Would you explain in a little more detail
21 first of all about any threats that Mr. Bonds made to you
22 during the course of your relationship?

23 A. Throughout the relationship, the threats were
24 such that he paid for my breast implants. And he would say
25 that if I ever left him, he would have to cut them out to

1 get them back.

2 He told me once that he'd cut my head off and
3 leave me in a ditch. And --

4 Q. Was that -- was there something in particular
5 that prompted either of those threats?

6 A. Home 10 minutes late. It was always something
7 like that. He was really very controlling.

8 Q. Was that throughout your relationship with
9 him?

10 A. Except for in the very beginning. In the very
11 beginning, he was all charm and charisma and none of that.

12 But about the time that he got married, he
13 started being more controlling about my whereabouts.

14 Q. Okay. And what, if any, changes in
15 temperament would you associate with the time frame when you
16 noticed the changes in his physical appearance?

17 A. The threats were always regular, and the one
18 time that I attribute specifically to that was May -- I
19 believe the first weekend in May. I have it indicated in my
20 notes.

21 I flew from Arizona to San Francisco to meet
22 him at a hotel there to spend time with him, just normal
23 spending time with him while he's here in town. And I
24 landed at the San Jose airport and had to drive to San
25 Francisco, and it made me, like, 20 minutes late.

1 And I walked in the door, and he grabbed me by
2 the throat and twisted me around and pushed me up against
3 the wall. And whispered in my ear that if I ever pulled
4 some fucking shit like this again, that he would kill me.

5 Q. When did this take place?

6 A. This was May -- I believe May 6th or May 3rd
7 of 2003.

8 Q. Of -- okay. Now, let me just jump back if I
9 could for a moment to the conversation that you had with Mr.
10 Bonds on the subject of steroids.

11 Did Mr. Bonds make any statements to you
12 during that conversation with regard to how prolific or how
13 many other players in major league baseball were taking or
14 using steroids?

15 A. No. His words were, "Everybody's doing it."
16 And then, sometimes being around him, he would talk to the
17 TV when there was commentary on regarding steroids or
18 McGwire or Sosa and the corked bat, for example. And he
19 would talk to the TV.

20 We had to watch Sports Center together all the
21 time. That's something that he insisted on.

22 So, he would say -- if somebody got on the
23 news and said, "I don't do something like that," he would
24 yell at the TV, "You know you did it. I know you did it.
25 We all know you did it."
